Summer Holiday Fun in Shropshire

Have fun with your friends, learn new skills, gain confidence and get involved!

Shropshire Council is working with local schools, voluntary and community organisations, and childcare providers to run an exciting holiday programme this summer, Shropshire HAF (Holiday Activities and Food).

There are free places available on the programme for children and young people aged 5 to 16, who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals.

Children and young people are invited to take part in a range of fun activities, happening at over 30 venues from across the county.



Use this Guide to find out what activities will suit your child/ren. There is something on offer for everyone, including; sports, music, arts, cooking, gardening and other exciting opportunities. Free nutritious meals will be provided at each session, as well as information on nutrition to benefit the whole family.

Booking: Your child/ren will be given a Shropshire HAF Voucher, by their school. The voucher entitles your child/ren to a free place on one of the many holiday programmes in Shropshire. **To book activity, please contact the holiday provider direct and quote your voucher code.** To find out if your child/ren are eligible for a free place on the programme this summer, please speak to your child/ren's school.

Many of the providers are running inclusive activity, with places available for children and young people with SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities). These have been highlighted in the Guide. When booking onto activity, please contact the provider to discuss your child's needs.

Shropshire HAF are working in partnership with the Actio Consortium. Actio are responsible for commissioning, promoting, and monitoring Shropshire Councils 'All In Short Breaks' – a menu of accessible and unique activities for children and young people with SEND. Actio is supporting the HAF programme by promoting inclusive opportunities within the HAF offer, to the 'All In' and Actio membership.
