Beam – operating from Palmers since Oct 17

Drop in Thursday pm Between 2 and 6 for 0-25-year olds, providing a relaxed environment to discuss mental health concerns.

First visit – general chat to understand situation including if any other services involved

One to one individual chats available for young people if requested

Multi agency team including; Youth worker, Counsellor, Therapist

Getting a permanent base developing in Wellington telford – will include offering workshops for parent carers and young people

Parents can come in on their own without the young person to discuss concerns about a young person's mental health or wellbeing and any difficulties they are having.
