Strategic Co-production

1. Ensure that everything in the co-production process is accessible to everyone taking part and nobody is excluded.
2. Ensure that everyone involved has enough information to take part in co-production and decision making.
3. Ensure that everyone involved is trained in the principles and values of co-production and any skills they will need for the work they do.
4. Ensure that frontline staff are given the opportunity to work using co-production approaches, with time, resources and flexibility.
5. Provide any support that is necessary to make sure that the community involved has the capacity to be part of the co-production process.
6. Ensure that policies and procedures promote the commissioning of services which use co-production approaches.
7. Ensure that there are policies for co-production in the actual process of commissioning.
