PACC's Preparation for Adulthood Navigator Impact Report



Following the completion of PACC's PFA Navigator Project we are reflecting on the last 3 years and what an important service this has been for the SEND community in Shropshire.

PFA Navigator Service:

- Provided 1:1 support to 416 families through signposting and helping them navigate their young person's journey
- Provided 1420 Community Support opportunities to Parent Carers and Young People through activities, training, and in-person events
- Attended 107 meetings and workstreams
- Provided over 150 in-person activities and events
- Produced 13 reports

A Young Person's Transition into Adulthood – Understanding Social Care with Professor Luke Clements





On 16th October PACC welcomed Professor Luke Clements to Shropshire to present at an in-person event about Social Care support as young people with SEND transition into adulthood.

Luke Clements is the Cerebra Professor of Law and Social Justice at the School of Law, Leeds University. Luke practised as a solicitor between 1981 and 2021 and in that capacity had conduct of a number of cases before the European Commission and Court of Human Rights.

Luke's academic research and litigation experience is primarily concerned with the rights of people who experience social exclusion, including disabled people and their carers.

Share your Feedback and Help to Improve SEND Services in Shropshire.



Every 6 months the Shropshire SEND System leaders from the Integrated Commissioning Board (Health) and Shropshire Council ask for your feedback on the services the Local Area SEND Inspection identified as in need of improvement. These are;

- Waiting times for Autism and ADHD assessments,
- Waiting times for Speech and Language Therapy services,
- The quality and timeliness of Education, Health and Care Plans.

The survey asks you to consider your experience of these service areas in the last 6 months and is open until the 6th October 2025. If you are waiting for an assessment or support from these service areas, please share your feedback.

Assistive Technology Lending Library Pilot – Survey



PACC previously shared information about plans to create a pilot 'Assistive Technology Lending Library' as part of the SEND and Alternative Provision Change Programme in Shropshire. These plans are now progressing and Shropshire Council would like to hear from SEND families about which items would be most helpful to purchase for the library?

They have created a short survey for families to complete and suggest the assistive technology they would like to have access to. The library would allow equipment and/or software to be available for schools/settings to 'try before they buy' and will be lent to schools for a fixed period of time (around half a term). At the end of the trial period, schools will return the equipment and will then decide if they wish to purchase their own equipment and software for continued use.

All equipment will be for use while in school only and will not be available for children and young people to take home.

The survey is open until the 10th October

Summary of PACC's Engagement with the Shropshire SEND Community 24/25



PACC was asked to provide a report to the Shropshire SEND and Alternative Provision SEND Partnership Board outlining its engagement activity and key messages heard during 2024/25.

The presentation provides an overview of PACC's aims, how we work and engage with the Shropshire SEND Community across all our work areas. It summarises the level of contact with parent carers and family carers and the key themes in the feedback that they shared with PACC.

It is clear that there are still some major challenges in delivering the support needed by SEND families in Shropshire. There are significant concerns about the timeliness of the EHCP process, the clarity of information provided by the local system, and the responsiveness of some services including BeeU and Children's Social Care.

This report will be presented to the SEND and AP Partnership Board in November 25.




SEN support in early years guide
