Agenda for the Meeting

- 1. Welcome and introductions
- 2. Special Resolution to make some changes to our rules (the PACC Constitution) as follows:
 - a) to reduce the minimum number of people needed on our Management Committee from 5 to 3, and the number needed to make decisions at meetings from 3 to 2.
 - b) to change the rules about how our annual accounts are reviewed.

To implement the changes, we require two-thirds of the people present at the meeting to vote in favour of the changes. If approved, the changes will happen straight away.

Reasons for the changes to the PACC Constitution

Fewer Trustees

It's been hard to find enough people to be trustees (the people who help run PACC). Many of our trustees are also busy caring for their families, which makes it tough to attend all meetings. Some trustees also work with PACC in other ways, which can mean they cannot be involved in all decisions due to conflicts of interest. By lowering the number of trustees and the number needed to make a decision (this is called a



quorum), we can continue to run PACC effectively while we are looking to recruit more trustees.

Changing the Audit Rule

Right now, our rules say we must commission a full audit of our accounts every year. However, the law only requires this for bigger charities. For smaller charities like PACC, a simpler check (called an independent examination) is usually enough. We want to change our rules so we can choose what's best each year. This will help us save money and still ensure we are meeting our legal responsibilities
